Understanding Guide Numbers – The guide number can help you calculate the range of a specific flash by dividing the guide number by the f/stop you plan on using. $\text{flash-to-subject distance} = \text{guide number} / \text{f-stop}$ For example, the Nikon SB-910 used in the video has a guide number of 34 meters. So, shooting at f4, you could use the following equation to figure out that the SB 910 has a range of 8.5 meters.
