Cash Assistance for Poor Families Has Plummeted If TANF had maintained the same reach to families in poverty as its predecessor, AFDC, had in 1996, nearly 3.6 million families would have received TANF in 2018, about 2.4 million more than reported for that year. Child care subsidies (also called vouchers and fee assistance): Each state receives funds from the federal government for a state-run child care subsidy program. These programs help low-income families pay for child care so they can work or attend school. Eligibility requirements are different in each state.

However, the cash can't be used for day-to-day expenses like groceries. It can be used for school outings, music lessons and other non-essentials that benefit the child. When the account owner reaches legal adulthood -- which is 18 in most states -- the custodian's role comes to an end.

Cash for childcare (CFC) schemes are commonly classified as male breadwinner family policy, assuming or being neutral in relation to the traditional gender division of labour in society as well as within the family (ibid.). Cash for care benefits involve low payments, assuming a main (usually male) breadwinner in the family.
