All events must be given for free. If admission fees are charged then further licensing is required from APRA AMCOS. The licence does not cover works performed in a Dramatic Context. From 1 January 2018, Dramatic Context means the performance of musical works: a) in conjunction with a presentation on the live stage that has: (i) a storyline; and

Casual Public Performances. For performances of live artists or recorded music that do not fit any event types described above. Works performed at political events are excluded, unless the songwriter's prior approval has been obtained in writing. Fees range from \$75.00, subject to music use and the number of events.

A public performance license is an agreement between a music user and the owner of a copyrighted composition (song), that grants permission to play the song in public, online, or on radio. Once the thorough scrutiny of forms is done the applicant is granted Performance License. Apart from this if the event involves ticketed Performance a License to sell tickets is also issued. This is granted at the Public Dealing Counter Lounge II between 9.30 - 12.30 on any working day (Monday - Friday).
