In order to publish/upload this Course-Scorm on Schoox, please follow the recommended settings for Articulate Storyline 2.

Our engineers put together Tempshare over one weekend to help folks upload and test Articulate Storyline content. Note: Tempshare is not an official, supported Articulate product.

Upload the files from your web publish folder. You can only upload 100 files at a time, so will need to load files in batches, keeping track of what has been done, and what is still left to do. Still within the story_content folder, create a slides Upload all files into the slides folder, completing in batches if needed.
